By 2025, the Bay Community Theatre will grow from a quaint small town theatre saved from closure to a thriving, proactive, and inspiring <u>anchor</u> for the entire <u>region</u>. We will provide our local <u>families</u> with an <u>affordable</u>, safe and positive experience for learning and joy.

"The Bay" will continue to be <u>primarily a single-screen movie theatre</u> but will also offer live performances and serve as an important gathering place for community events.

By 2025, the theatre will have <u>updated technology and infrastructure</u> to provide our patrons a top quality experience and to protect our historic building.

The theatre will be <u>financially strong</u> with low or no debt, careful and transparent expense management, and revenues from ticket sales, fundraising, memberships, and sponsorships.







New Seats

- 100% of the new seats were sponsored by local patrons.
- ➤ 187 seats:
 - "Amsterdam" model w/ "The Bay" logo on custom end panels.
 - All seats are wider than old seats. Extra-wide row spacing maintained.
 - First 2 rows are removable for events (meetings, dancefloor, etc).
 - Made in Michigan by Irwin Seating.

Old Seats

- > 100% of the old seats were sold to community members.
- > Remaining parts were recycled.

Wood Floor: full sanded and refinished w/ 4 coats.

Aisle Runners & LED Lighting: cleaner and safer.

\$100,000+ Investment. Fully funded by donations and MEDC grant.



Our Priorities for 2023

Your Theatre Experience

- Great movies! & Live Events.... 364 Days a Year!
 - o "Made in Michigan" Series. Holiday movie favorites.
 - Kennedy's Kitchen Concert (March). Holiday Concert (Dec).
- Develop plans to upgrade lobby, entrance and facade.

Team & Governance

- Hire a general manager (allowing board members to focus on longer term).
- Careful financial management. Collaborative, no-drama culture.
- Fundraising to cover operations, reduce mortgage, and invest in capital improvements.

Community Engagement

- Continue to work w/ local schools and community groups.
- \$1 movies to make The Bay accessible to more families.
- Grow Cinema Society with monthly films.
- Expand and engage membership base.



In summary

- 2022 was an historic year.
- Audiences continued to return after the pandemic. +70%.
- Excellent series of "sold out" live events. Strong community focus.
- The Bay received lots of "love". \$200,000+ in needed upgrades!
 - New movie screen, curtains, seats, floors, lighting, popcorn maker, fire detection and more.
- The theatre is financially strong. \$100,000 of debt paid off in 2022. Money in the bank.
